Frontex only keeps the personal data you provide (except photos) for the time necessary to fulfil the purpose of this project, namely for a maximum period of six months after the finalization of the photo contest. Data will be automatically deleted at the end of this period. The photos you submit will be uploaded in the Frontex photo repository (LENS) and used as imagery for other products such as publications. All personal data is in electronic format and stored in restricted folders of Media and Public Relations Office. Access to your personal data is provided to the MPR staff responsible for carrying out this processing operation.
