

**MANAGEMENT BOARD DECISION 37/2021**

of 16 June 2021

**authorising the Executive Director to negotiate working arrangements with selected EU entities****THE MANAGEMENT BOARD**

Having regard to the European Border and Coast Guard Regulation<sup>1</sup> (“Regulation”), and in particular Article 68 thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) In accordance with Article 68(1) of the Regulation, the Agency shall cooperate with Union institutions, bodies, offices and agencies, within their respective legal frameworks.
- (2) Pursuant to Article 68(2) of the Regulation, the cooperation referred to in Article 68(1) of the Regulation shall take place within the framework of working arrangements. Such arrangements shall be subject to the Commission's prior approval. The Agency shall inform the European Parliament and the Council of any such arrangements.
- (3) Pursuant to Article 22(1) of the Rules of Procedure of the Management Board of the European Border and Coast Guard Agency<sup>2</sup> (“Rules of Procedure of the Management Board”), the Executive Director shall inform the Management Board of his intention, and request prior authorisation to negotiate a working arrangement in accordance with Article 68(1) and (2) of the Regulation and with authorities of a third country, including the scope, nature and purpose of this arrangement as well as its financial impact.

**HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:***Article 1***Subject**

1. The Executive Director is hereby authorised to renew or negotiate new working arrangements with the following entities:
  - a) European Agency for Safety and Health at Work - EU-OSHA (new)
  - b) European Asylum Support Office - EASO (renewal)
  - c) European Union Advisory Mission for Civilian Security Sector Reform Ukraine - EUAM Ukraine (new)
  - d) European Union Agency for the Operational Management of Large-Scale IT Systems in the Area of Freedom, Security and Justice - eu-LISA (renewal)
  - e) European Union Capacity Building Mission in Niger - EUCAP Sahel Niger (new)
  - f) European Union Integrated Border Management Assistance Mission in Libya - EUBAM Libya (new)
  - g) Joint Research Centre - JRC (new)
